

For your final writing of the semester, you will be writing a piece that would belong in the book *What We Keep*.

You will write about at least one item that you have kept over the years. This particular piece of writing is more like telling a story than writing an essay.

The requirements are as follows:

- 1) You will need to bring or have a digital copy of a picture of the item.
- 2) Your piece of writing will need to include the following details (in any order):
  - a. a detailed description of the item
  - b. how you came into possession of the item
  - c. who and what you associate with the item
  - d. an explanation of why you have kept the item.
- 3) Your writing will need to have at least five hundred words.
- 4) You will need to proofread your writing, freeing it from errors and ensuring you have a thoughtful, interesting response that enables the reader to understand your attachment to the item.
- 5) You will then prepare the final presentation of this project following Mrs. Chancellor's instructions.
